20. **2012 Marktree Semillon/ Chardonnay, S.E. Australia** 15.45
No oak, clean fruit, lively new wave style.
21. **2013 False Bay Chenin Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa** 16.75
Quite full, dry but rounded, with gently tropical fruit and clean, appley notes.
22. **Alasia Sec, Vino de Tavola, Italy** 16.95
Dry and delightfully scented with elderflower aromas and crunchy, fresh Muscat grape flavours.
23. **2013 Pinot Grigio, Terrazze della Luna, Trentino, Italy** 18.75
Fully flavoured, dry and minerally with an attractive note of almond.
24. **2012 Murphy's Unoaked Chardonnay, Murray River Valley, Australia** 19.75
Ripe and round with balancing acidity and generous body.
25. **2012 Pinot Blanc Reserve, Cave de Turckheim, Alsace** 22.25
Crisp, light but not weedy, with clean fruit and plenty of flavour
26. **2013 Sauvignon de Touraine, Domaine de Rablais, France** 22.75
Tingly pure with the green nettle freshness *of high grade Sauvignon, this is an excellent example.*
27. **2012 Bascand Estate Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** 24.95
A green leaf, crushed nettles nose precedes a dry palate with plenty of gooseberry crunch.
28. **2011 Chablis, Domaine Chevallier, Montallery, France** 27.95
Delicate, mouth-watering but not tart, pristine clean. Classic, keen style.
29. **2011 Sancerre, Andre Dezat, Loire Valley France** 28.50
Classic Sancerre, full of grassy Sauvignon fruit with a crisp, dry finish.

36. **Marquis de La Cour, Blanc de Blancs Brut, Loire Valley, France** 20.75
Dry, soft and fresh with a good, brisk fizz and clean fruit flavours.
37. **Rasselet, Brut Non-vintage, Oeuilly (Marne Valley), Champagne** 43.00
From a terrific, small, family-owned House. Freshly full and very elegant, this is the perfect way to celebrate!

Red Wines

40. **2011 Mesta Tempranillo, Viño de la Tierra de Castilla, Spain** 14.75
Intense in colour with vivid fruit and juicy summer berry flavours. Lovely with a wide variety of food.
41. **2011 Marktree Merlot/Cabernet, South East Australia** 15.75
Soft and appealing with clean, ripe, stone fruit flavours.
42. **2012 Tesoro de los Andes Malbec/ Bonarda Mendoza. Argentina** 18.25
Dark in colour and jammed with black cherry fruit, full and clean with considerable depth of flavour.
43. **2010 Bordeaux Classique Ginestet, Bordeaux France** 19.25
Very decent entry level claret with balance and depth.
44. **2010 Rioja, Crianza, Añares, Spain** 19.45
A mellow marriage of soft fruit with well-judged, gentle oak influence. A great performer with most meats.
45. **2012 Murphy's Shiraz, Murray River Valley, Australia** 19.75
Soft and full with abundant, dark fruit and satisfying body.
46. **2011 Primitivo, Tacco Barocco, Sampietrana Puglia. Italy** 21.25
An authentic expression of this original grape showing blackberry fruit and a touch tar & smoke Juicy and long-a good example.
47. **2011 Chausseynette, Vin de France, C&D Chaussy** 22.95
Effectively this is declassified Chateaufeuf du Pape from the Mas de Boislauzon estate. Rippling with dark juicy fruit and the vigour of youth.
48. **2010 Côtes du Rhône, Domaine de la Mordorée, France** 23.75
Ripe and full; a deep red of old-fashioned intensity from a beautifully run estate. A fantastic example boxing well above its weight.
49. **2011 Bascand Estate Pinot Noir, Marlborough** 25.25
Relatively pale and unoaked with a pretty, scenty Pinot nose, rounded, juicy fruit on the palate and very mild tannins.
50. **2011 Cairanne'Le Ventabren' Domaine des Escaravailles. France** 26.75
Invitingly open and ripe nose with a concentrated palate balanced with just enough tannin, young, but fleshy and approachable.
51. **2011 Chateau du Barry, Grand Cru Saint Emillon, Bordeaux, France** 29.95
This is 80% Merlot and 29% Cabernet Franc with benefit of cask ageing. It has class, nice fine texture, and a round elegant feel. May be enjoyed now or left a couple of years.

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
